If a breeder cannot attend a sale and requests the technical advisor to buy on his/ her behalf, breeders are requested to confirm the specific lot number, animal ID number and the maximum amount excluding VAT by email or whats app. When the request is to buy female animals at own discretion, then the maximum amount must be specified. The Society will not be held accountable for "faulty" purchases.
